

A called meeting of the Conyers, Georgia, City Council was held Wednesday July 18, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. in the City Manager's Office located at 1184 Scott Street, Conyers, Georgia. Mayor Vince Evans called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The purpose of this meeting is to hold the second of three public hearings on the proposed millage rate for the City of Conyers

**Old Business -**

**1. PUBLIC HEARING. Number two of three on the proposed increase in the millage rate for the City of Conyers. The Conyers City Council has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 7.37 percent. This increase will result in a millage rate of 15.284 mills, an increase of 1.05 mills over the current rate.**

Mayor Evans opened the public hearing for Resolution No. 670 at 6:34 p.m.

Mr. Kenny Johnson addressed the Council with questions and concerns related to taxes. After explanation from the Mayor and Council, Mr. Johnson was asked if he had any additional concerns. He advised he did not. There was no one else present who wished to address the Council.
