

A called meeting of the Conyers, Georgia, City Council was held on January 15, 2013, at 12:00 noon in the City Manager's office for the purpose of approving Resolution No. 610 setting the qualifying fees for the November 5, 2013 General Election; and Ordinance No. 907 amending Chapter 1 of Title 9 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Conyers regarding alcoholic beverages licensing and regulation.

Roll Call – Present: Mayor Randy Mills; Council Members Chris Bowen, Vince Evans, John Fountain, Gerald Hinesley, and Cleveland Stroud.

New Business:

1. Request approval of Resolution No. 610 setting the qualifying fees for Mayor and for Council Members from District One and from District Two, Post One for the November 2013 General Election. Assistant City Attorney Carrie Bootcheck presented Resolution No. 610 to the Council and stated that the qualifying fee for Mayor is \$99.00 and \$72.00 for Council Member. Assistant City Attorney Bootcheck asked for Council's approval of Resolution No. 610. Council Member Cleveland Stroud made a motion to approve Resolution No. 610. Council Member Vince Evans seconded the motion. Mayor Mills called for a vote of the Council. All members voted aye. Mayor Mills declared the motion carried.
2. Request approval of Ordinance No. 907 amending Chapter 1 of Title 9 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Conyers in its entirety for the licensing and regulation of alcoholic beverages in the City of Conyers. City Manager Tony Lucas presented Ordinance No. 907 regarding the licensing and regulation of alcoholic beverages in the City of Conyers to the Council.

After discussion among the Council and other interested attendees, Council Member Cleveland Stroud made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 907 and waive the second reading. Council Member Chris Bowen seconded the motion. Mayor Mills called for a vote of the Council. All members voted aye. Mayor Mills declared the motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Council the meeting was adjourned at 1:10 p.m.
