New Business -


1. PUBLIC HEARING. The first of three public hearings on the proposed increase in the millage rate for the City of Conyers. The Conyers City Council has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 7.37 percent. This increase will result in a millage rate of 15.284 mills, an increase of 1.05 mills over the current rate.

Mayor Evans opened the public hearing for Resolution No. 670 at 10:00 a.m.

There was no one present who wished to address the Council.

Mayor Evans closed the public hearing at 10:05 a.m.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Council Member Cleveland Stroud made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Gerald Hinesley seconded the motion. Mayor Evans called for a vote of the Council. All members voted aye. (Council Members John Fountain and Blair Barksdale were absent.) Mayor Evans declared the motion carried. The meeting concluded at 10:07 a.m.
